Payloads Workgroup Charter

Real Estate Data is typically delivered as a package comprised of a set of data for a specific business need. The RESO Data Dictionary defines all the fields (specific characteristics) available to be included in a payload. The Payloads Workgroup purpose is to define Payload Categories based upon Real Estate Industry business need and which fields are to be included in each Payload Category as specified within the RESO Data Dictionary.

- IDX Payload in DD1.5 BOD approved 6/21/16

RESO BOD (1)

January 21st, 2016 Certification Committee Passed a Motion regarding IDX Endorsement and Mandatory 1.5 requirements:

"APPROVED: Motion passes IDX Payload will be a special endorsement and required for Silver Level Data Dictionary v1.5 certification."

Use Case (3)

- Small to Medium MLS
- Only one Data Feed for IDX/BR
- Very narrow set of data 10-20 Fields

Scope: Define an IDX Payload that is data rich and is consumer friendly.

Internet Data Exchange (IDX) Payload for Broker Reciprocity (RESO Cert)

- Internet Data Exchange (IDX) Payload, also referred to as the Broker Reciprocity Payload (NAR), allows applicants to provide a sub-set of all fields collected for a specific record. The Data Dictionary 1.5.0 IDX Payload consists of 219 fields from the Property Resource.
- **NOTE 0-1:** Internet Data Exchange (IDX) Payload **DOES NOT** refer to any MLS display rules. RESO **DOES NOT** require changes to an MLS' Display Rules Policy to receive this endorsement. Certification vs Endorsement

- A Payload Endorsement is an additional recognition (for those who have earned a Data Dictionary Certificate) demonstrating that a specific sets of fields are available in a data feed of the same name.
- NOTE 0-1: A "certificate" refers to the whole Data Dictionary. An "endorsement" refers specifically to payloads. An applicant MUST receive a Data Dictionary Certification (at any level) BEFORE receiving an endorsement. An example could be an applicant receiving a "Data Dictionary 1.5.0 Gold Certificate with an IDX Payload Endorsement." When referring to the payload itself, it may be referred to as a "RESO Endorsed IDX Data Feed."



IDX Payload Testing Rules (4)

(MUST)

- Create a separate IDX Feed in addition to Full Feed
 - RESO Endorsed IDX Data Feed
- If a field exist in Full feed and tagged as IDX payload it must be exposed.
 - If field does not exist, do nothing
 - You can include additional fields beyond tagged as IDX
- Standard Name
 - Competing requirements Gold, Platinum field

IDX Payload Testing Rules (cont)

- Legal (not required)
 - Close Price, Longitude / Latitude
- Name IDX
 - RESO Endorsed IDX Data Feed
- ListingContractDate or OnMarketDate
 - UnparsedAddress or Parsed



IDX Endorsement Wrap-up

• Drivers

- IDX Endorsement is required 1.5 DD Silver Cert
- Fields are tagged as IDX in the 1.5 DD
- Addressing Use Case
- IDX Payload Testing Rules

Process

- Submit Full
- Create and Submit separate IDX Payload
 - Include all fields tagged IDX
 - Exclusions
