

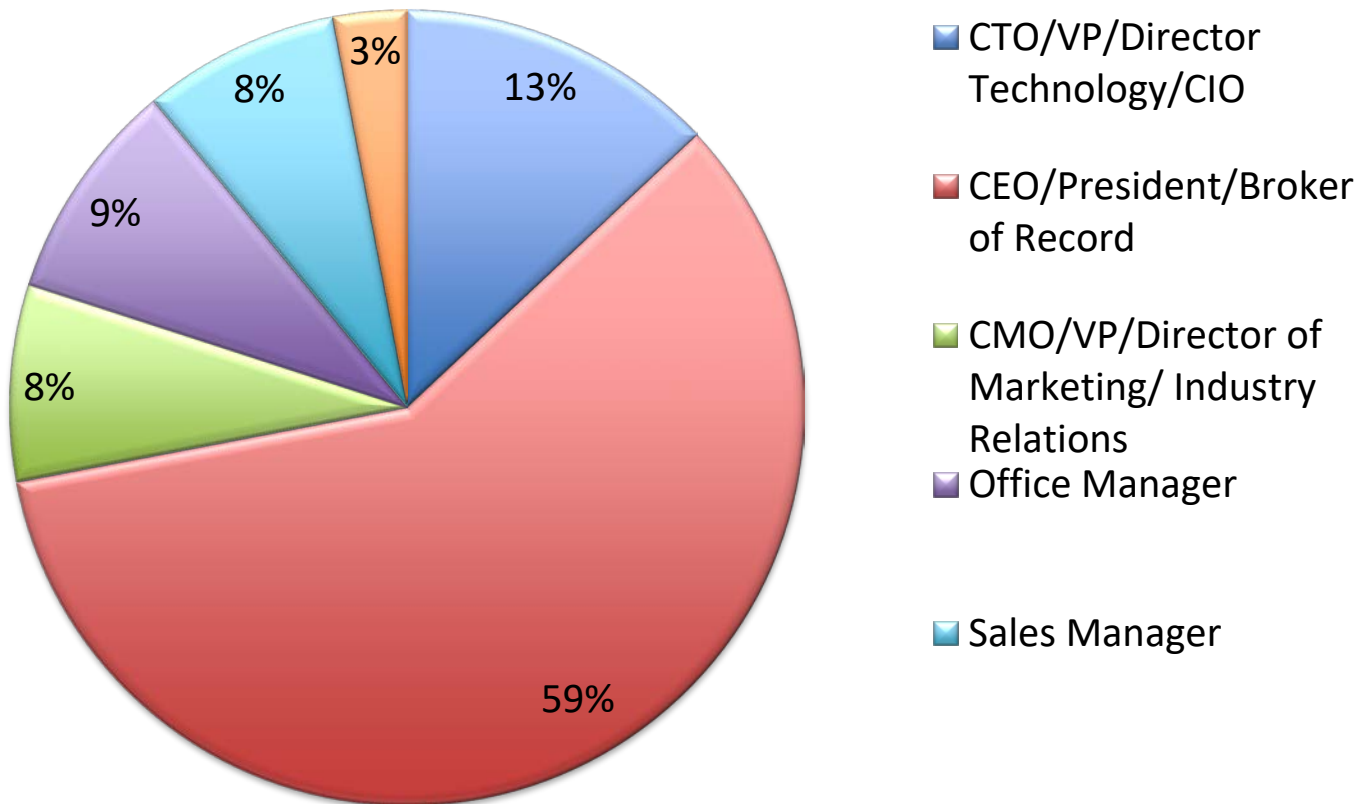

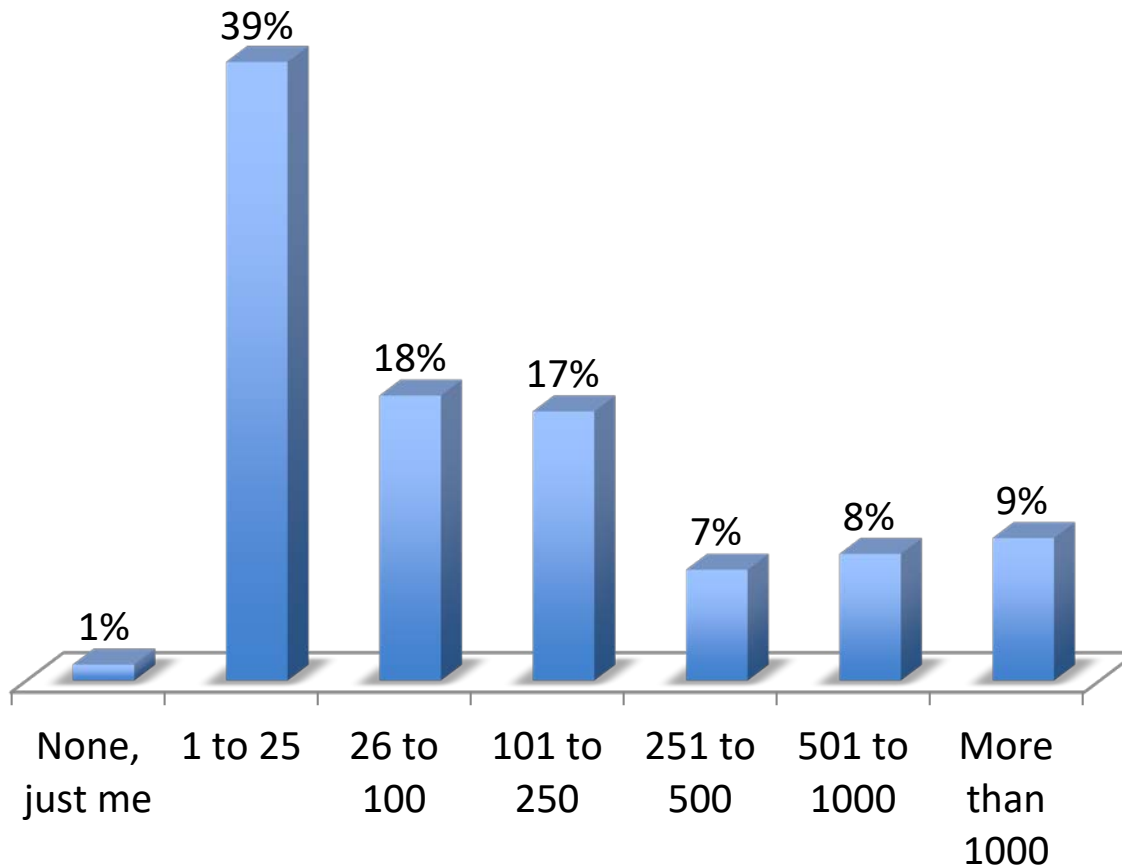

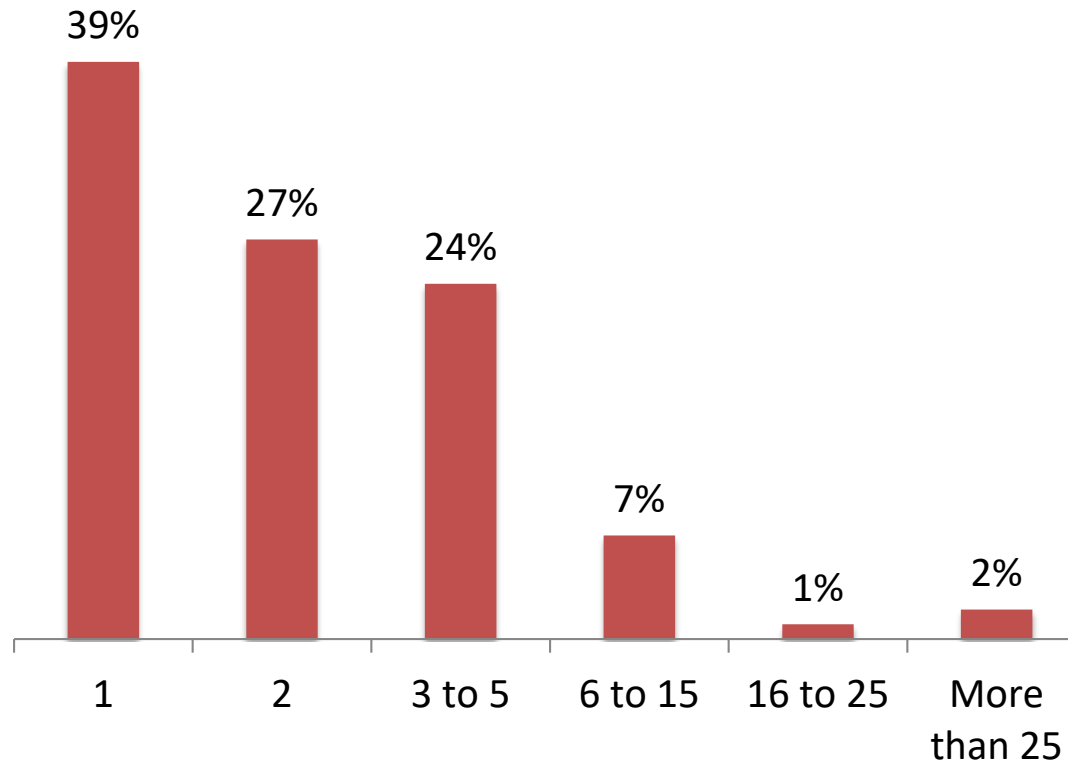
# Size of brokerages represented in survey

**Approximately how many agents do you have in your brokerage?**



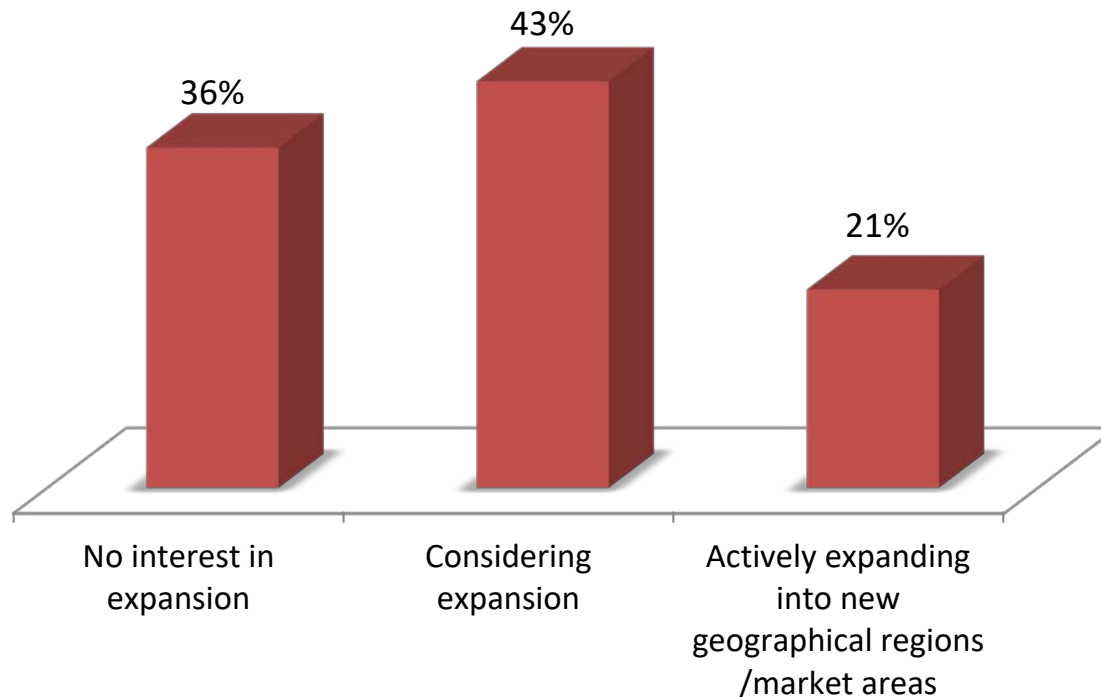
# Most brokerages surveyed are operating between 1 and 5 regions

How many MLS regions do you operate in?



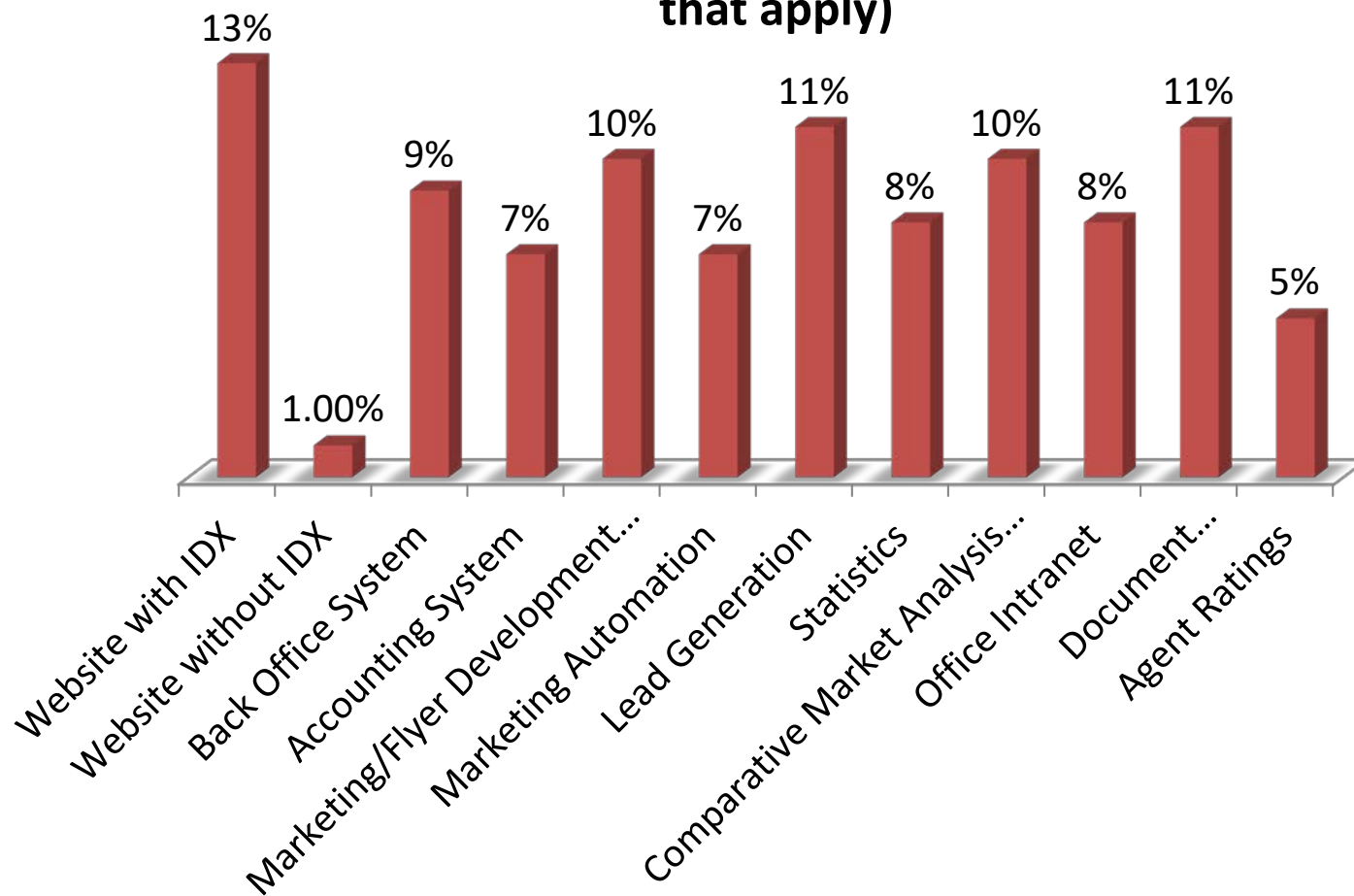
# Nearly 2/3 interested in expansion

**How interested/active is your brokerage in expanding into new geographical regions/market areas?**



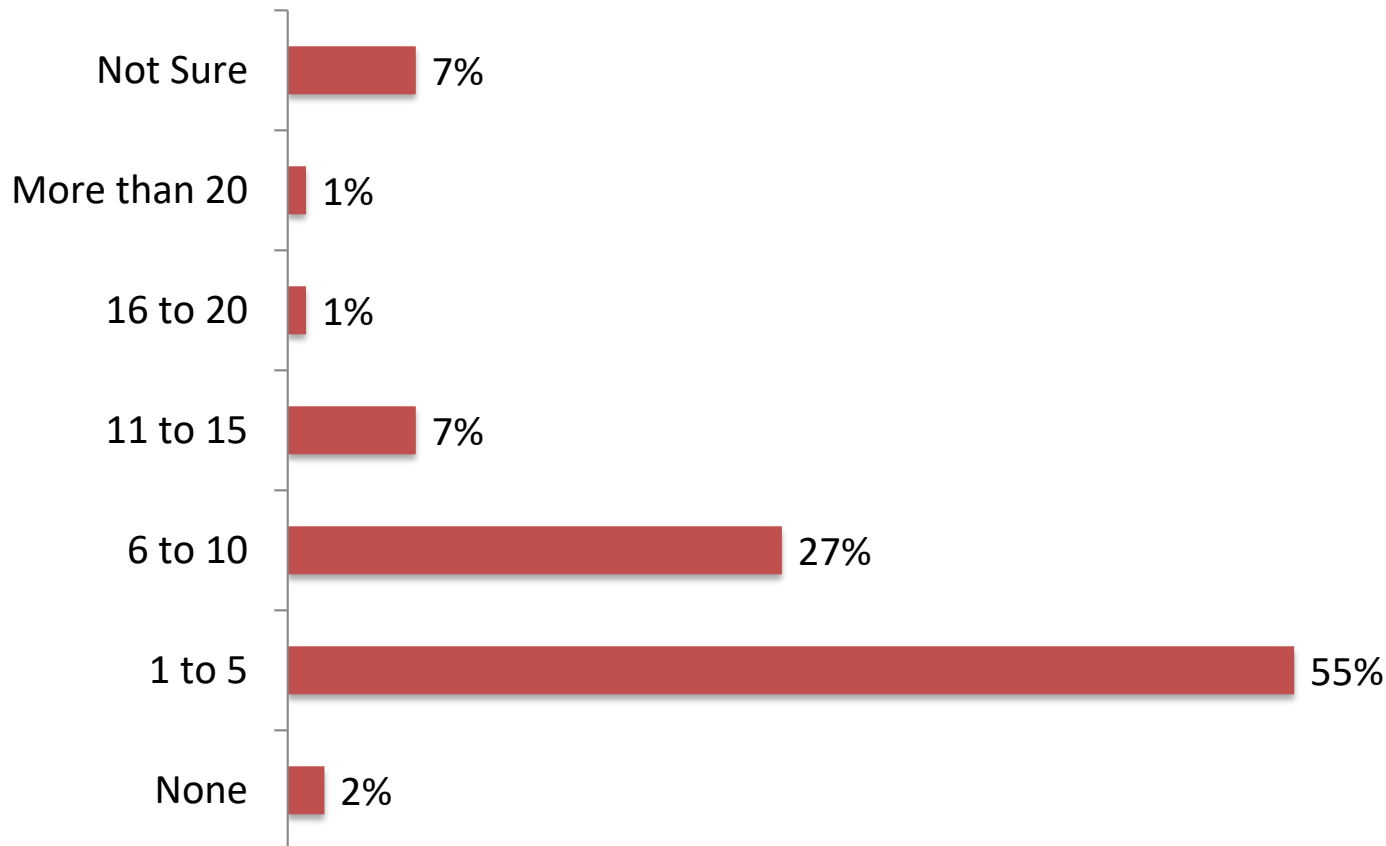

What software and tools do you offer through your brokerage? (Choose all that apply)



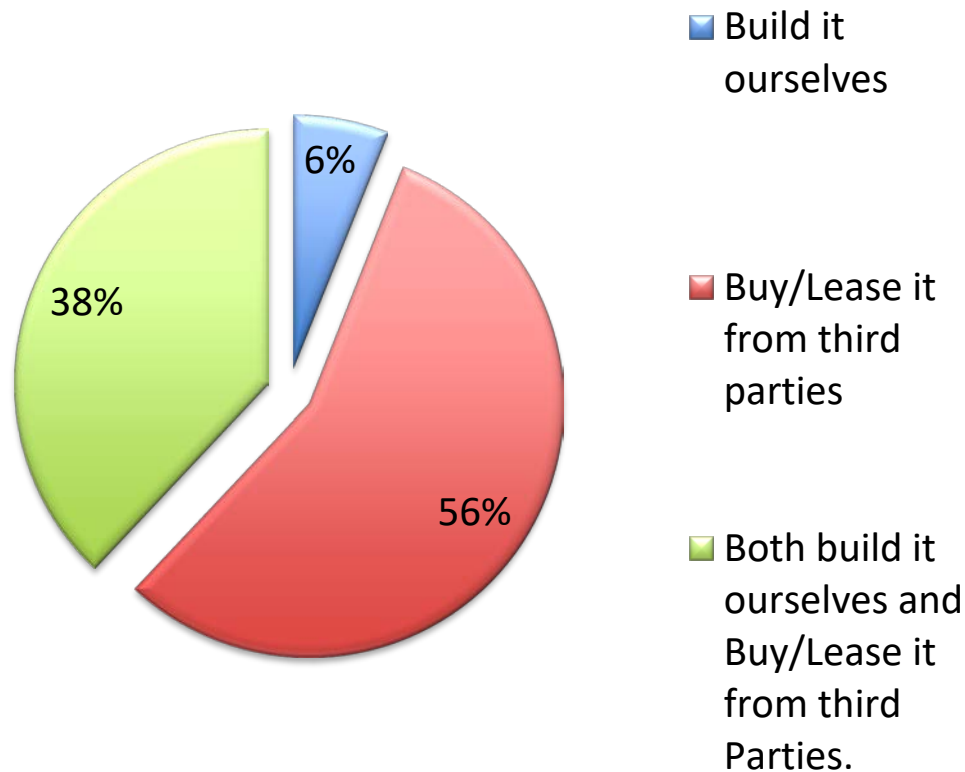
# Most have multiple tools that require MLS data

# Most use software from third parties

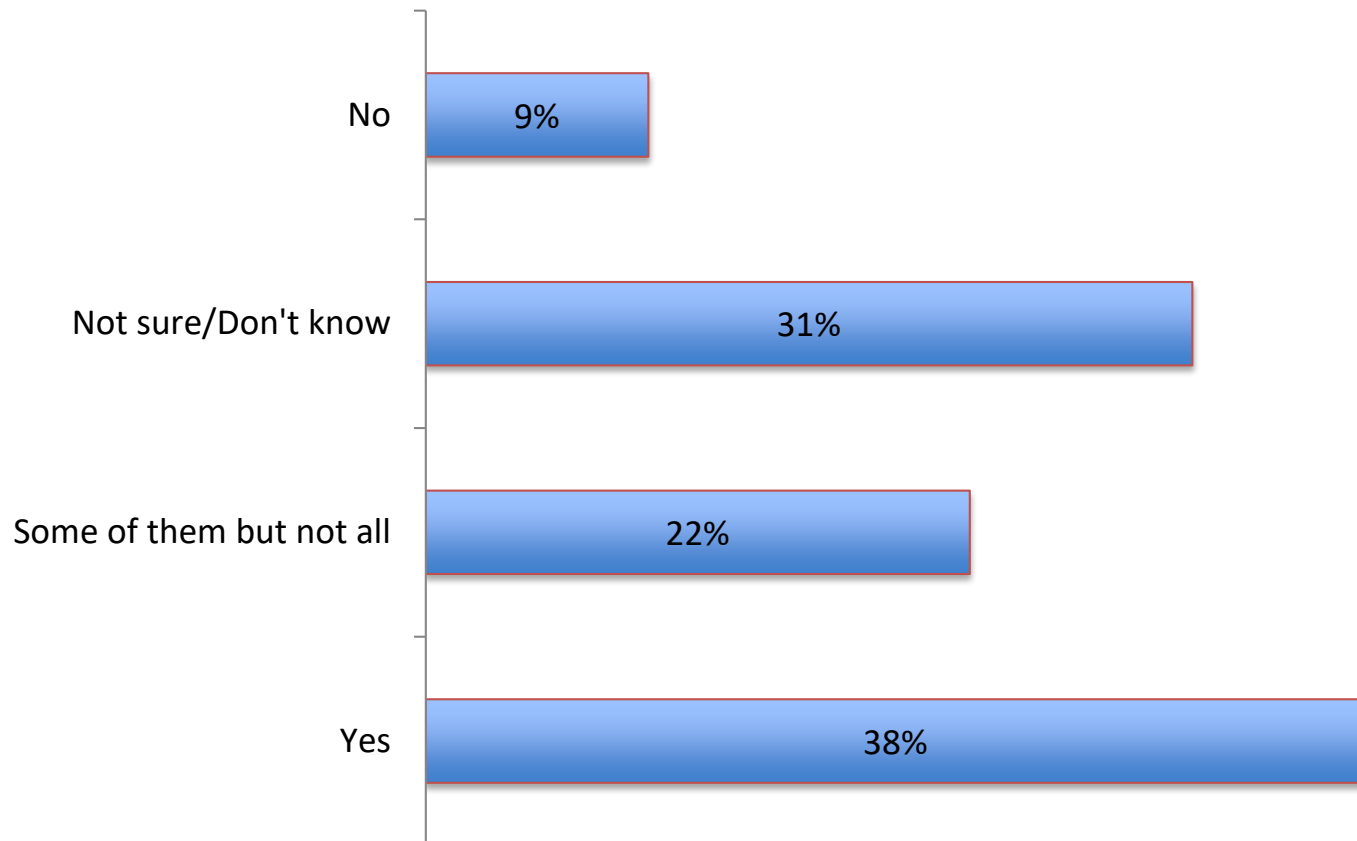
How do you source/build the software you use in your brokerage?





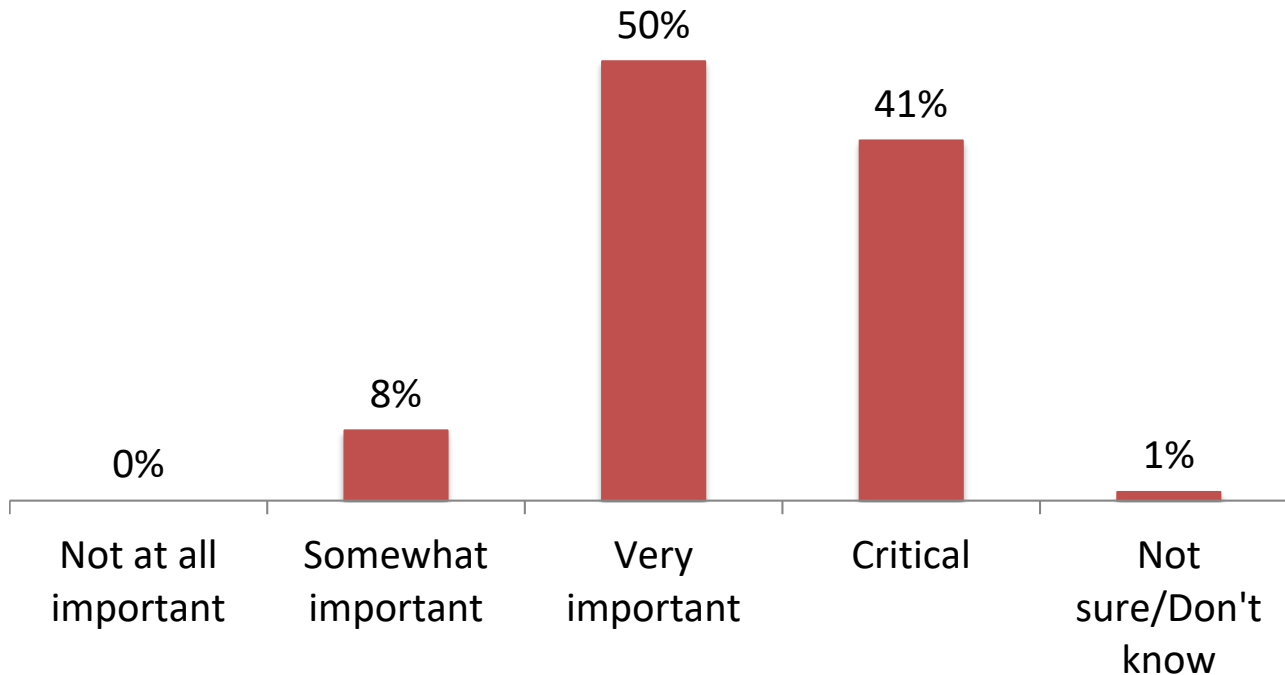
# No clear understanding how MLS data flows between broker tools/systems

**Does your MLS data flow seamlessly from one broker system to another without having to be re-entered multiple times?**



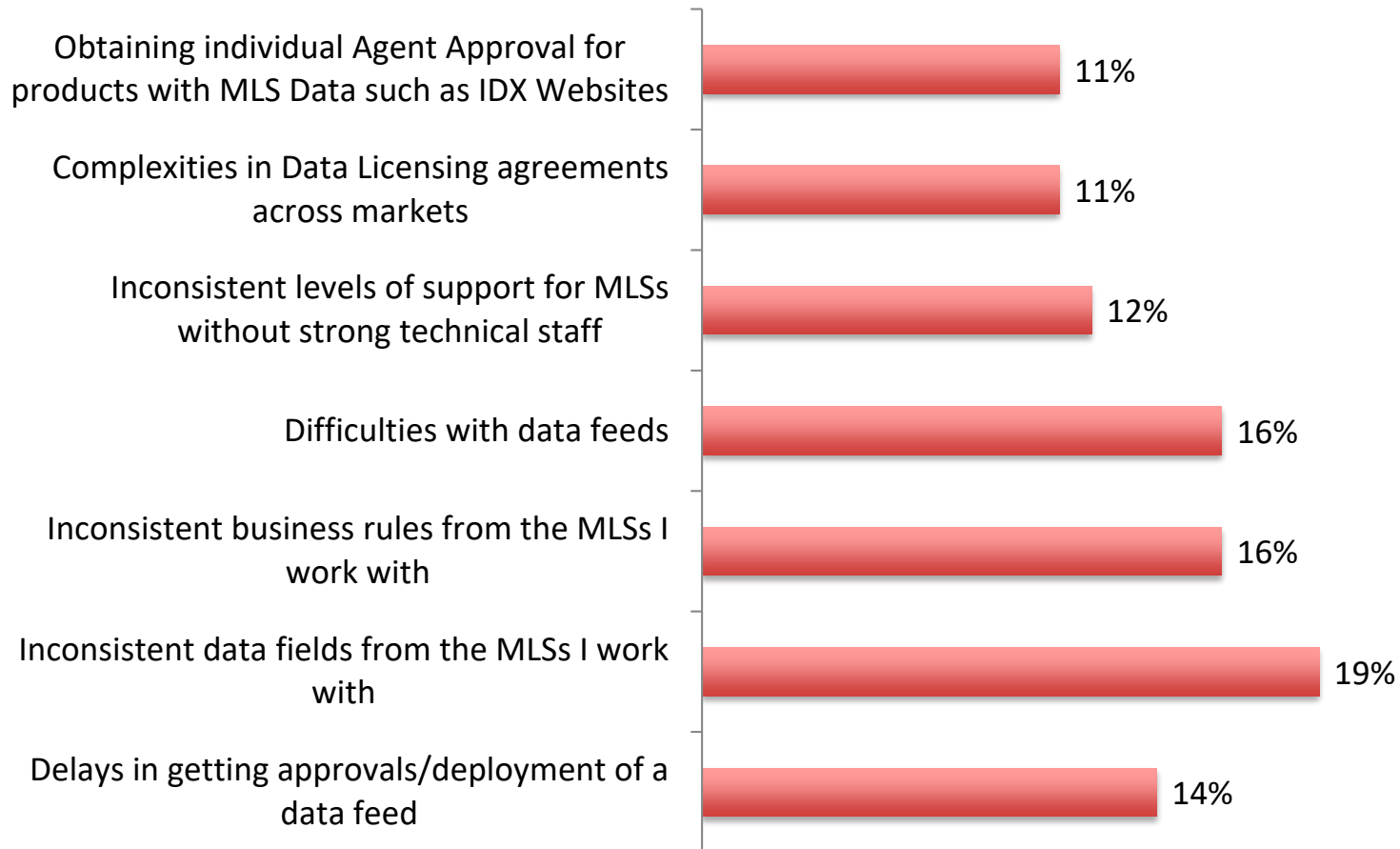
# 91% believe data standards are Important/Critical

**How important is it to your brokerage that all MLSs you work with offer a consistent set of data fields for you to use on your website, internal systems and document processing programs?**



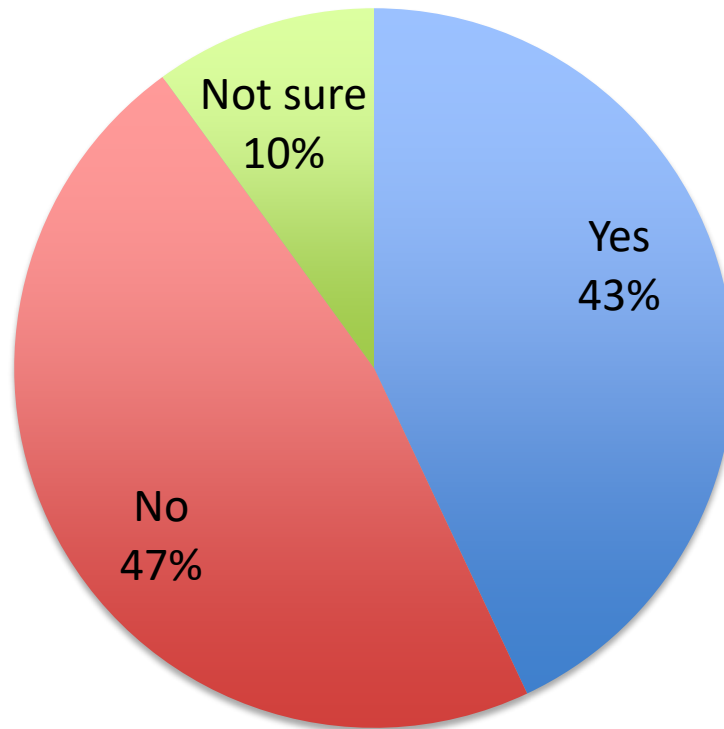
# Inconsistent data fields among MLSs - single largest data challenge

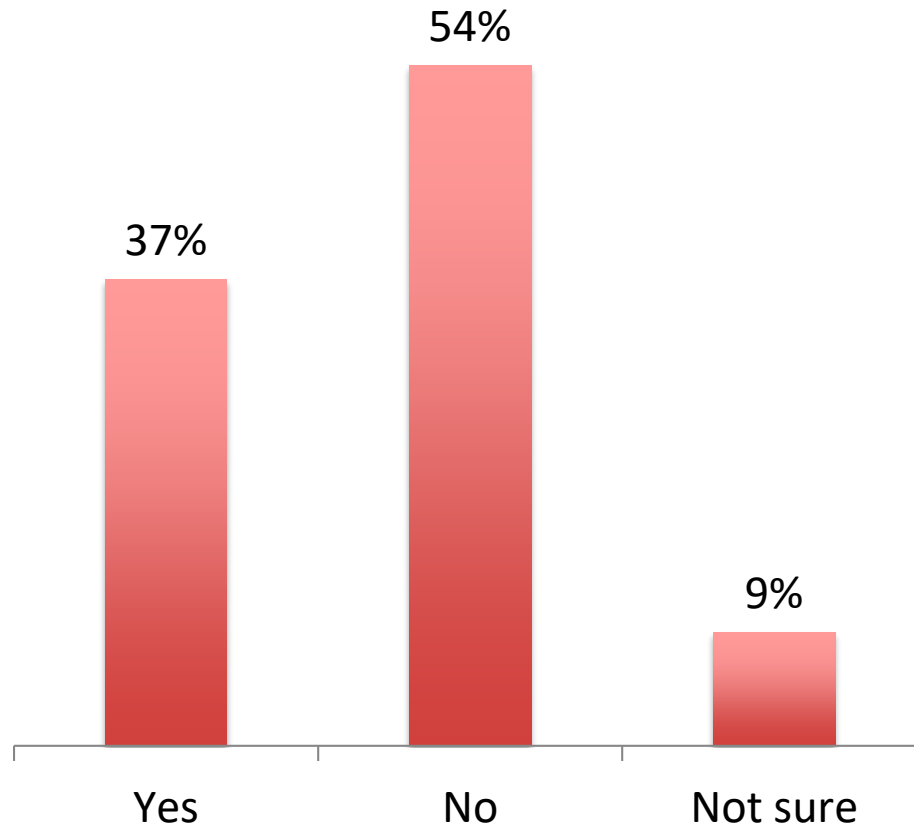
# Less than ½ are familiar wit RESO Standards

**Are you familiar with the Real Estate Standards Organization and the RESO Data Dictionary?**



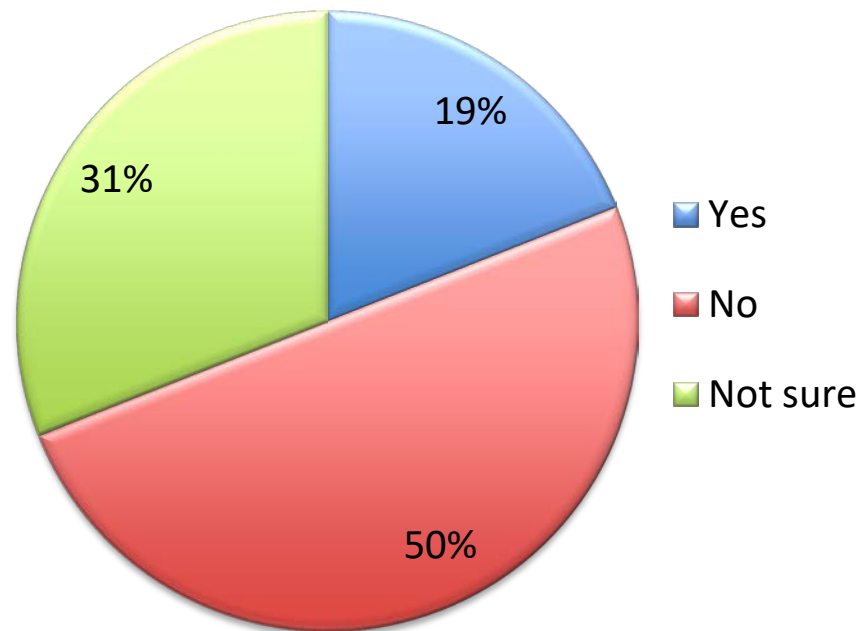
# Awareness of Data Dictionary Certification mixed

**Are you aware that all MLS organizations have been required to adopt the RESO Data Dictionary by January 1, 2016?**



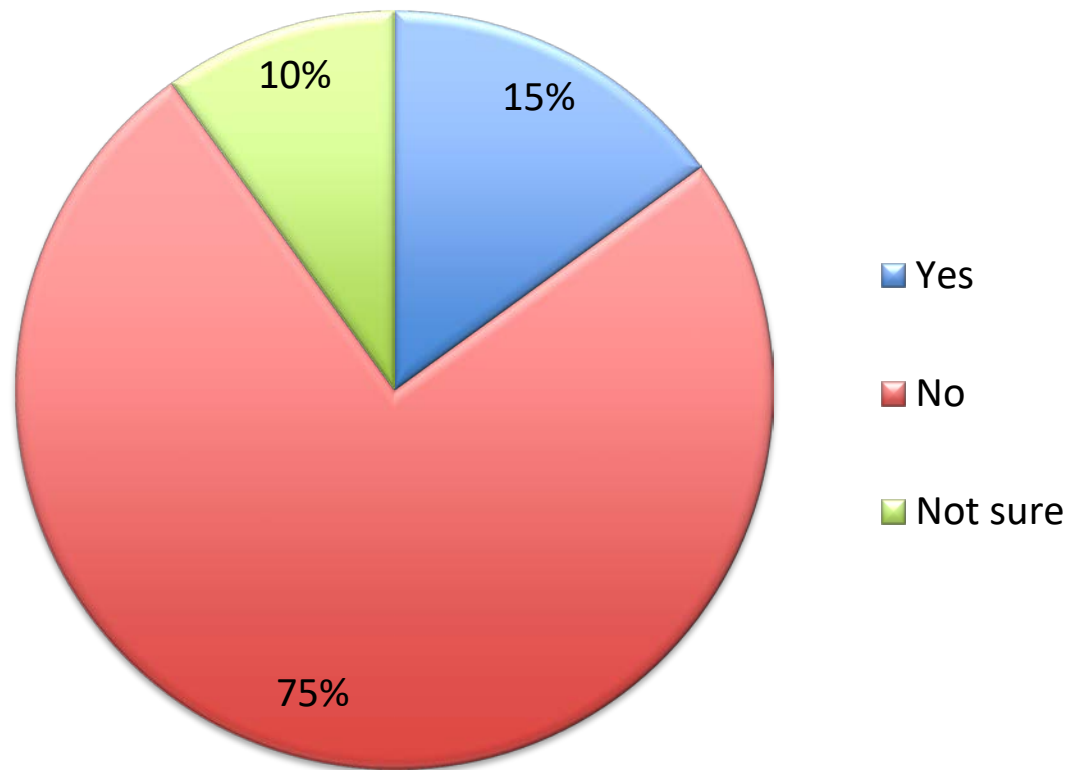
# MLSs are not Promoting RESO Certification

**Have your MLSs made you aware that they are Data Dictionary-compliant?**



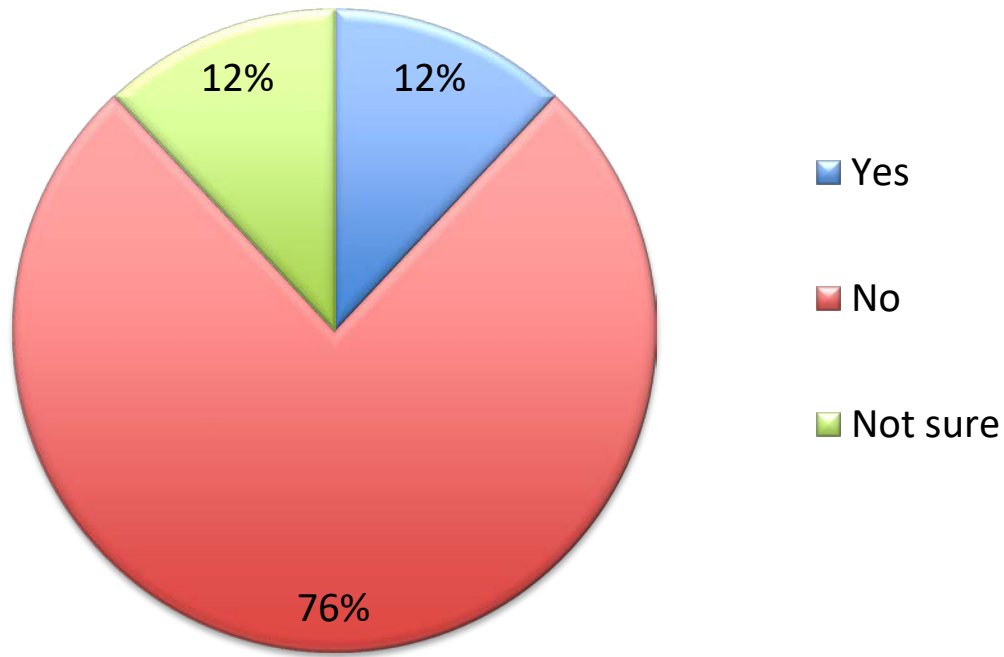
# Minimal awareness of the RESO Web API

# Very little awareness of Web API deadline

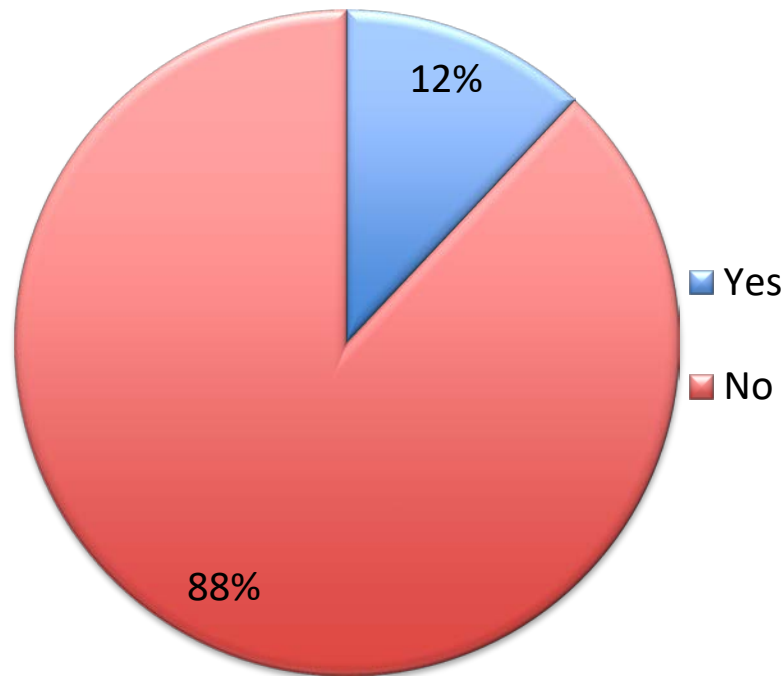
**Are you aware that all MLS organizations have been required to adopt the RESO Web API by June 30, 2016?**





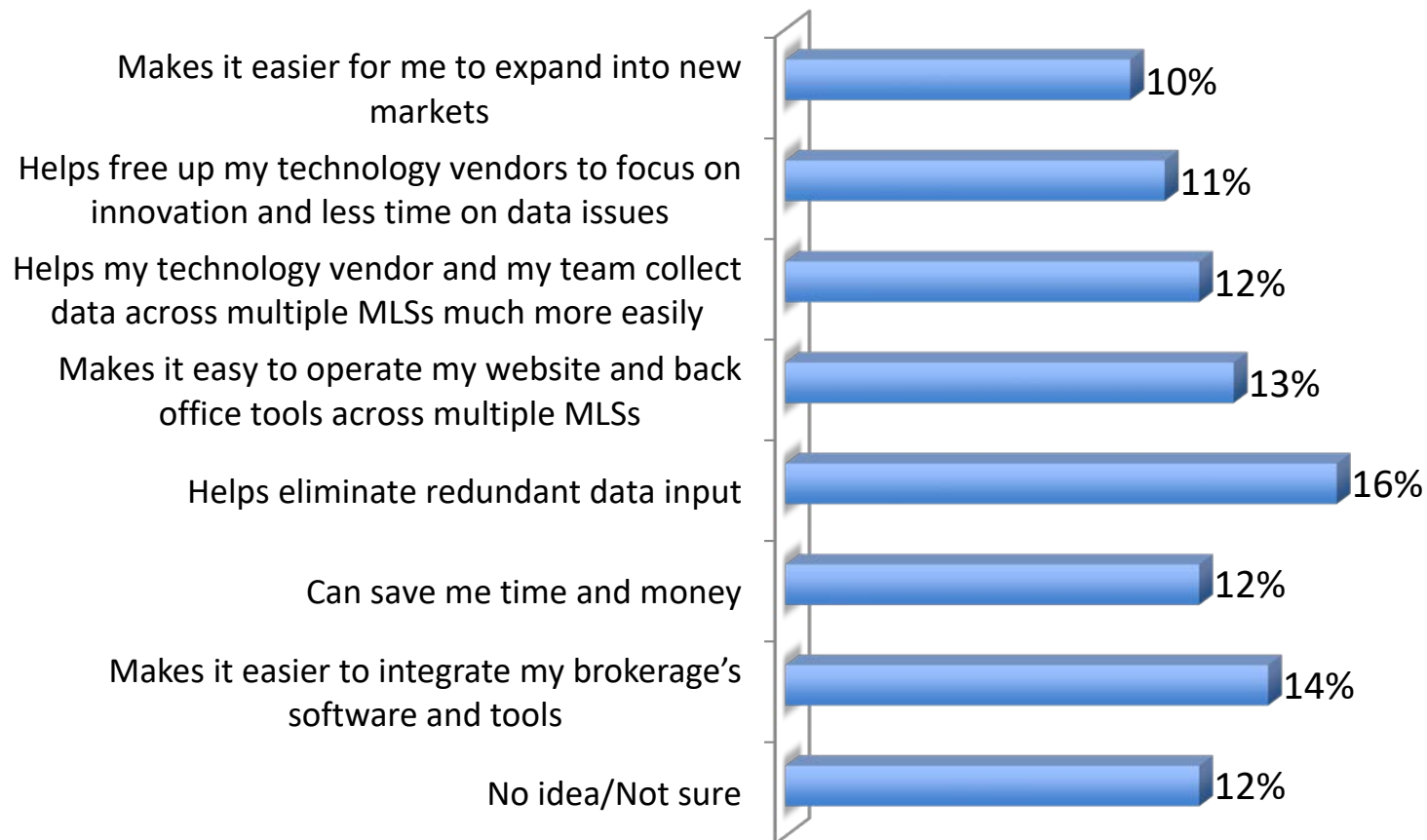
# Minimal awareness of MLS level certification on RESO.org

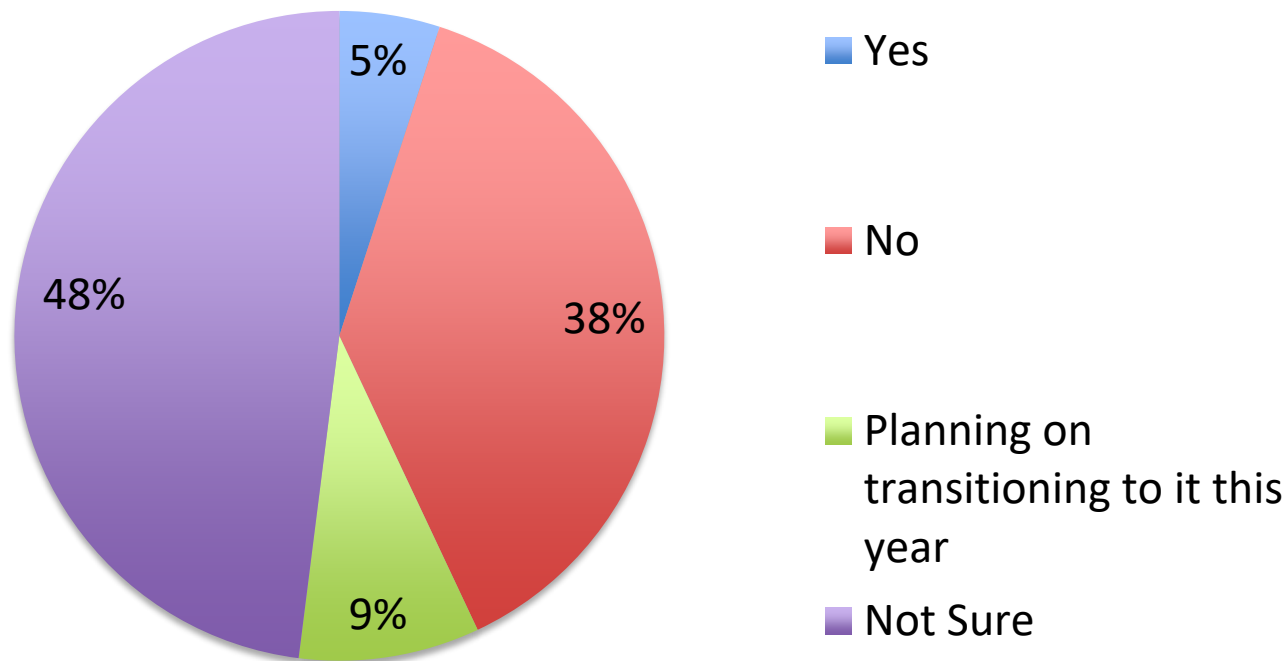
# No clearly understood benefit of RESO yet

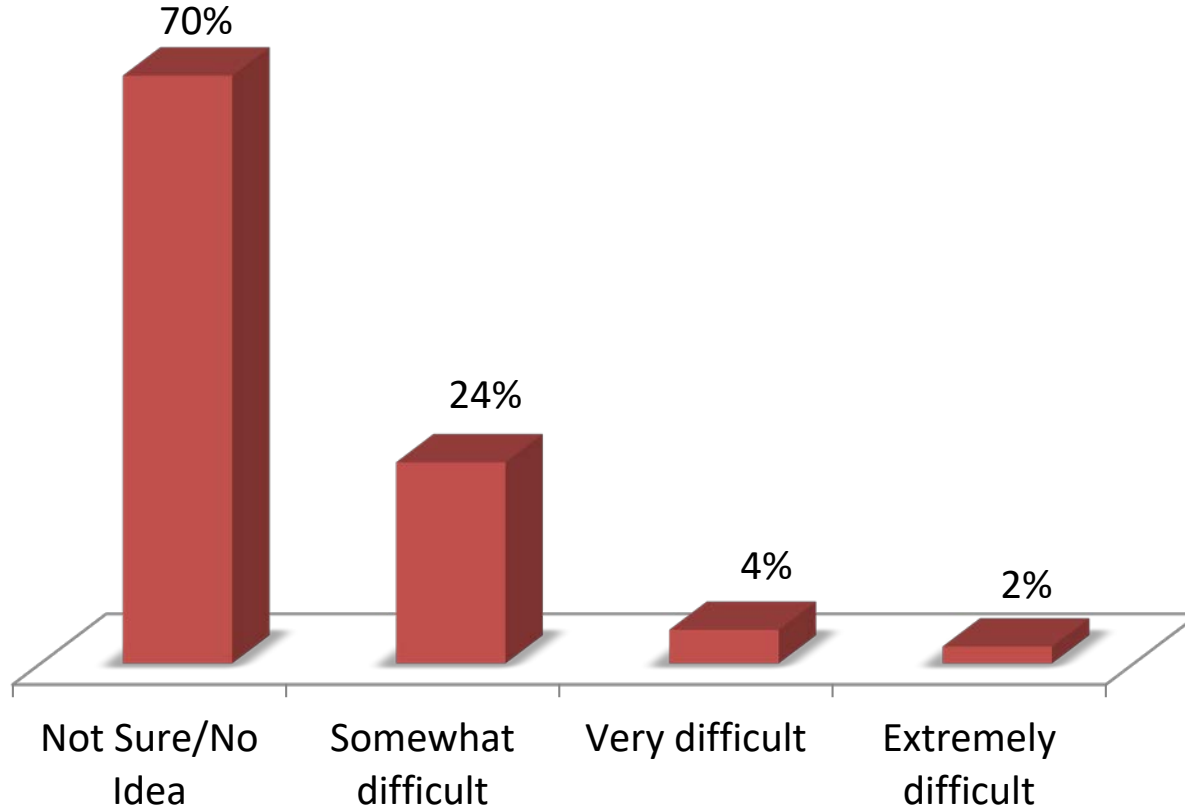
# Little awareness of RESO standards usage

**Is your organization utilizing the RESO Data Dictionary Standard in their internal products and platforms?**



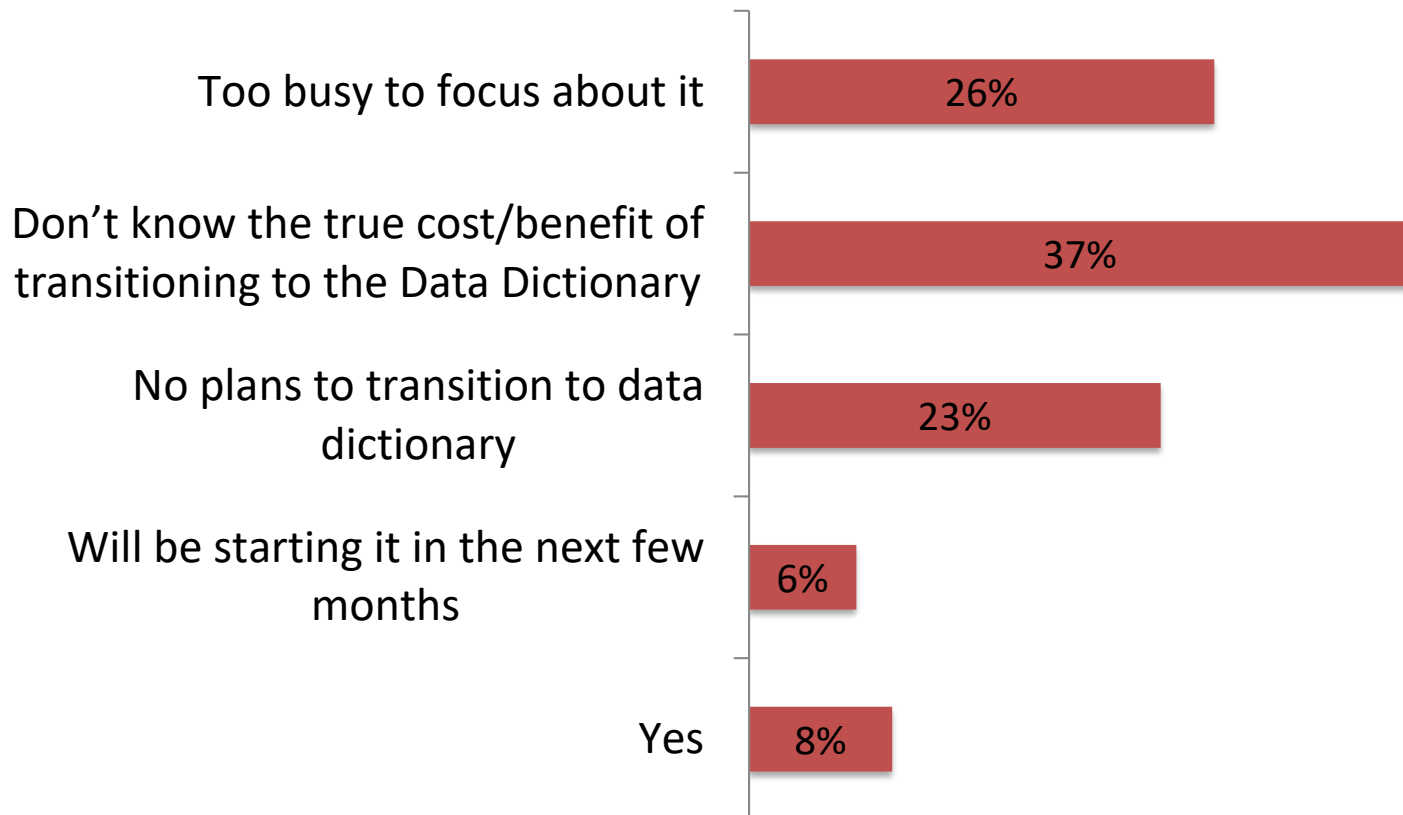
# No understanding of the difficulty of transition to RESO standards

**How difficult do you believe it will be to transition the data fields you use in your systems today to Data Dictionary-compliant fields?**



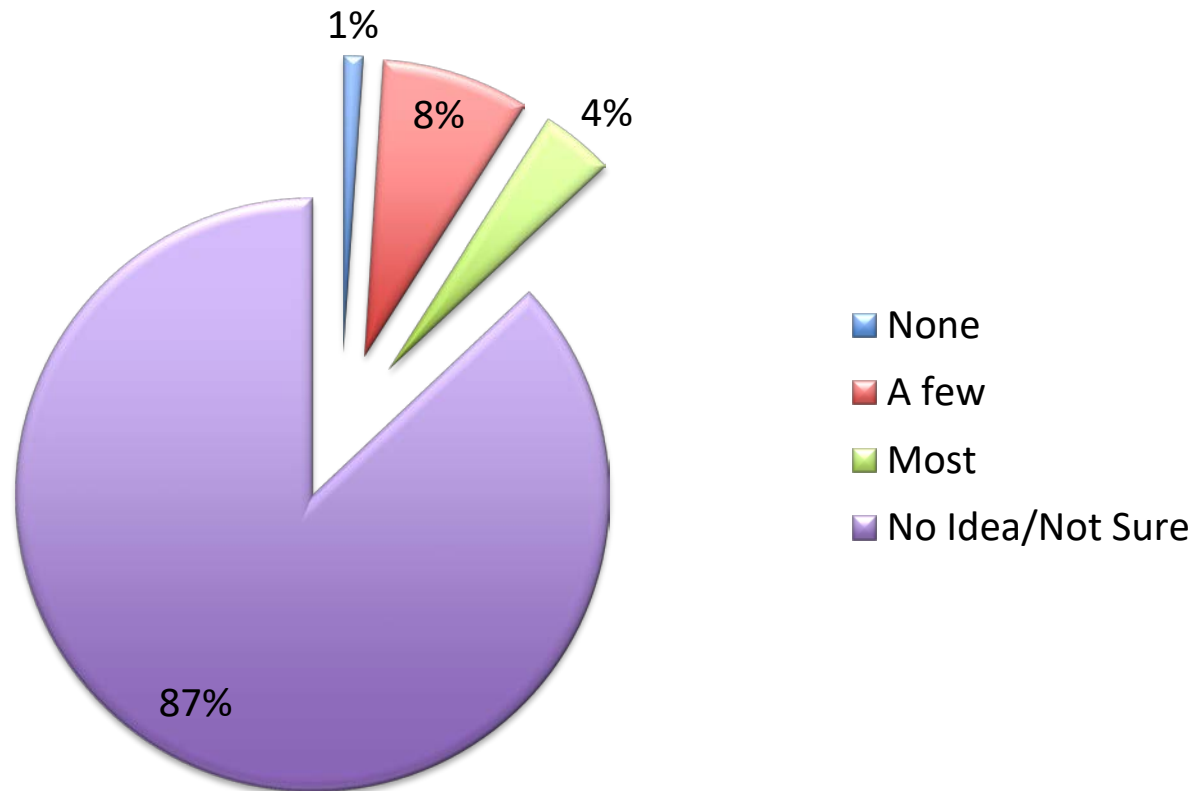
# Cost/Benefit understanding not there yet

**Have you begun to transition your systems to be able to leverage Data Dictionary compliant fields?**



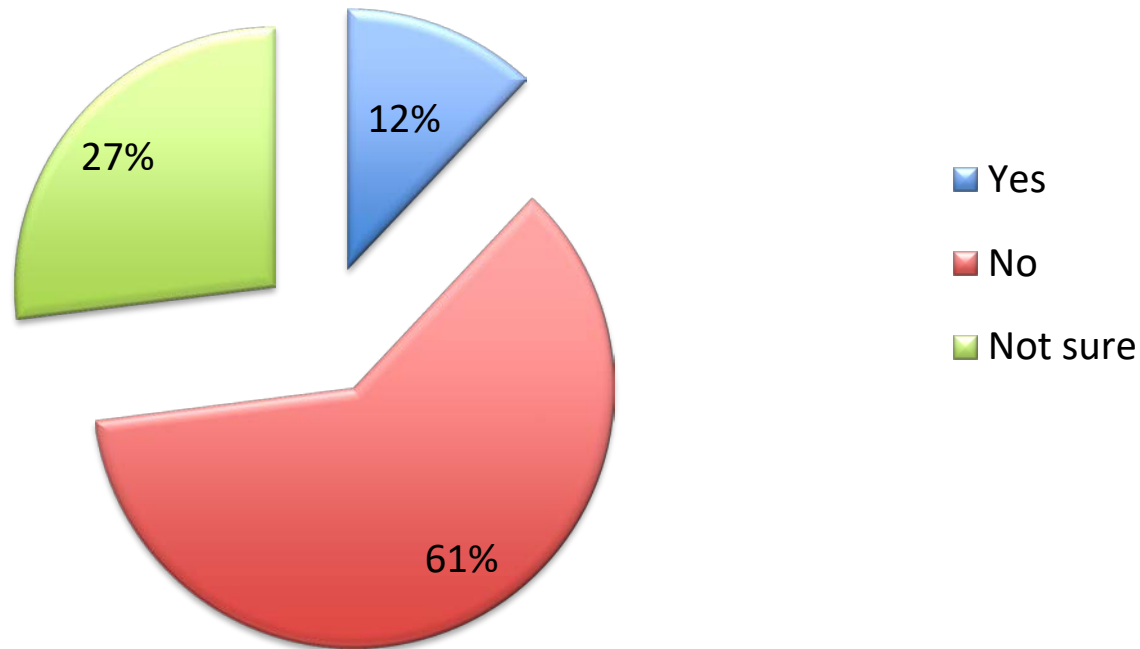
# Little awareness of technology partner compliance

How many of your technology partners are now Data Dictionary-compliant?



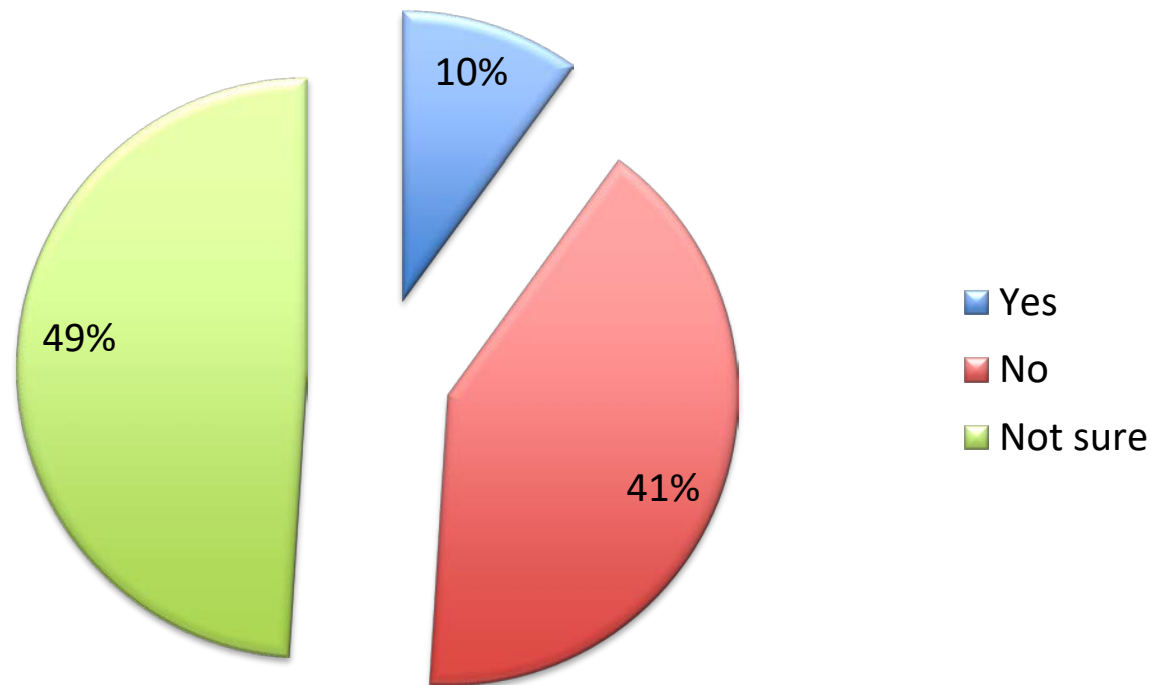
# Few have requested tech partners to be RESO compliant

# Higher than average broker membership among respondents

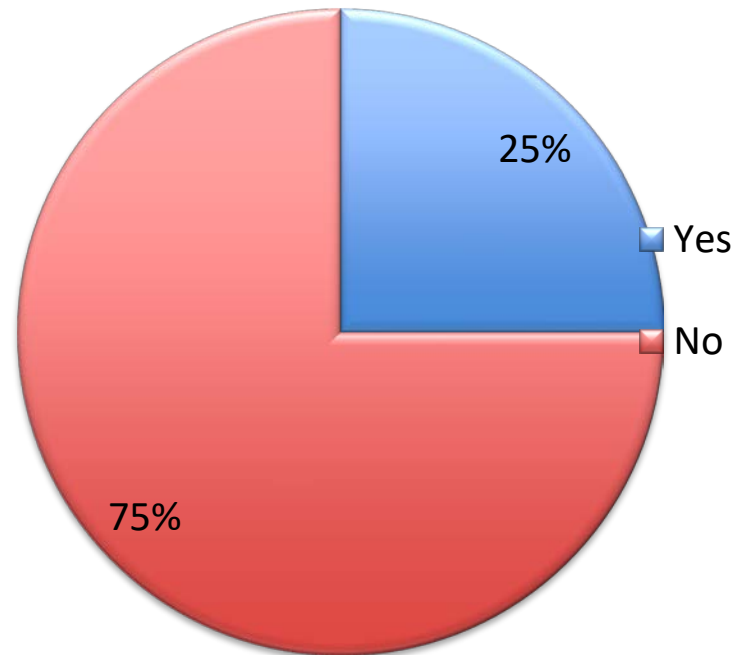

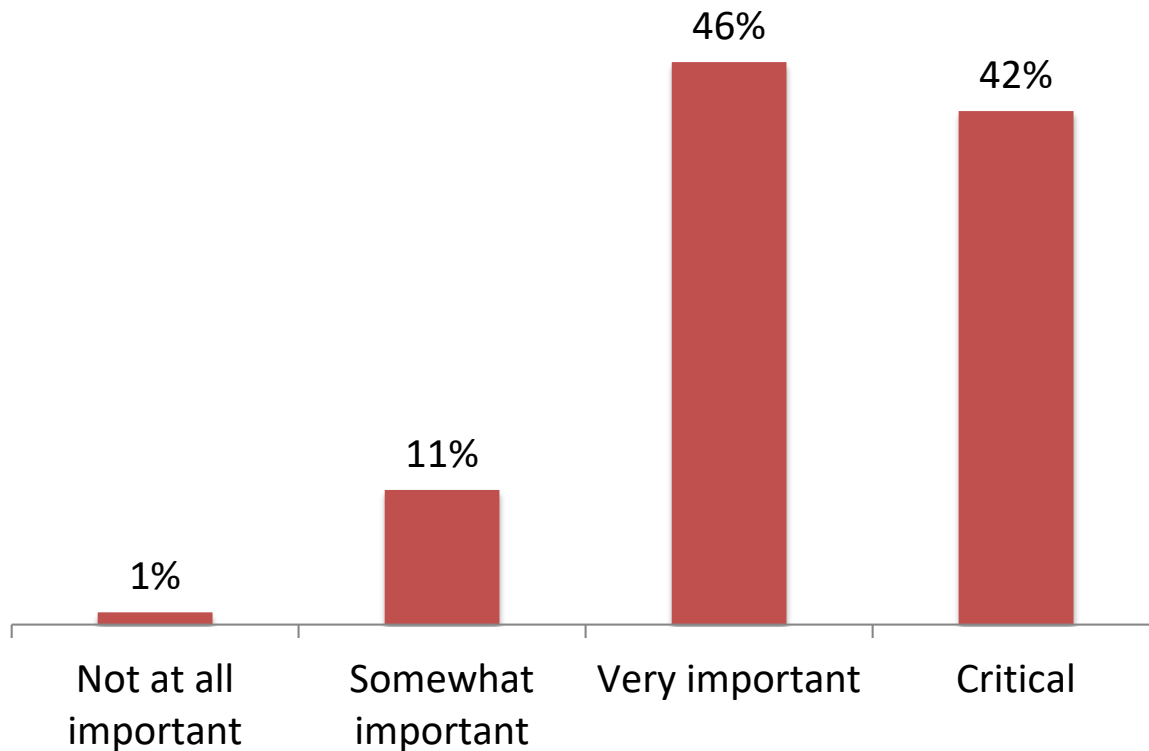
# ¼ of RESO Broker members are involved in Work Groups

**Are you involved with any RESO Work Groups?**



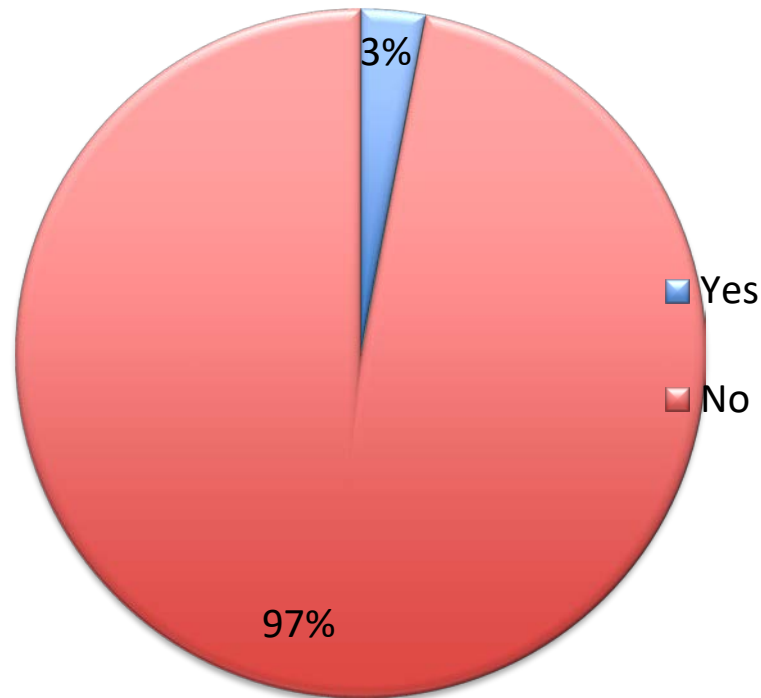
# 88% want the Broker voice represented in Standards Setting

**How important do you believe it is for brokers to have a voice in the setting of data standards for the real estate industry?**



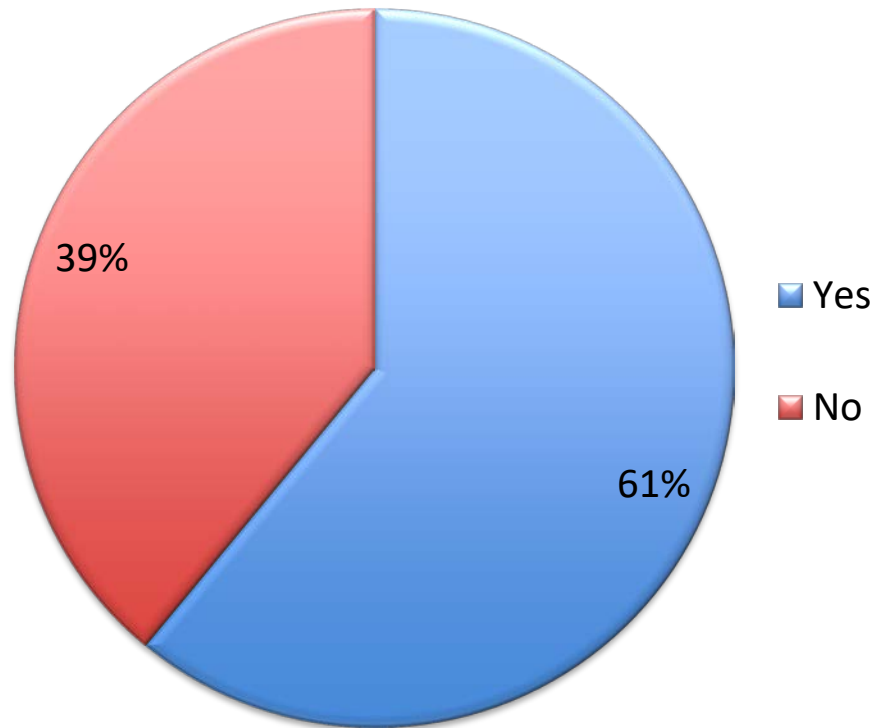
# Very little RESO conference attendance to date

Have you attended a RESO Conference?



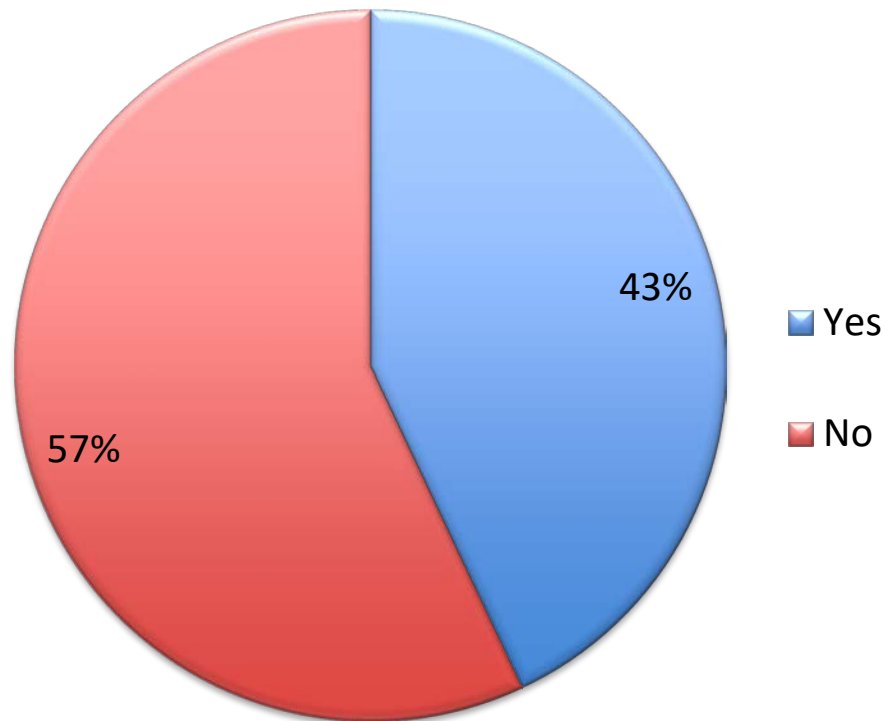
# Nearly 2/3 are aware of Upstream and BPP

# Broker Survey General Observations

- Lack of knowledge about RESO & it's purpose
- Low motivation to implement
- Interest in expansion of brokerage
- Minimal familiarity with RESO and the process of introducing it
- Strong interest in broker voice in setting RESO standards
- Little awareness of Technology Partner involvement/compliance to RESO

# 2016 – 2017 Strategic Tactics

- Launch program to MLSs inviting them to promote RESO Compliance
- Host Webinars to introduce RESO to brokers and how it will benefit them
- Expedite broker case studies
- Create awareness campaign to brokers about value of RESO
- Continue to recruit broker membership, encourage workgroup/standards involvement and conference attendance
- Recruit Broker Ambassadors to promote RESO
