# NAR MUS Policy Mandates

- Data Dictionary v1.3 or v1.4 Certification:
   January 1st, 2016
- Web API Transport Certification:
   June 1st, 2016
- All REALTOR® owned or affiliated Multiple Listing Services must certify through the RESO Certification Program
- The MLS must apply for certification, not the vendor (Data Dictionary



  - SupplementalApplication Information(Data Dictionary Only)







#### Vendors: What do I need to do?

- Use Transport Testing Tools to test your systems.
- Visit <a href="https://reso.org/certification">https://reso.org/certification</a> and Apply
- Electronically Sign the RESO Trademark Agreement
- RESO will begin processing compliance testing and work with you as needed
- Once complete, RESO will issue you a Certification Certificate





#### DD: What do I need to do?

- Contact your MLS Vendor regarding certification
- Work with your MLS Vendor to adopt the Data Dictionary v1.3 or v1.4. This might require "mapping" data
- Visit <a href="https://reso.org/certification">https://reso.org/certification</a> and Apply
- Electronically Sign the RESO Trademark Agreement
- RESO will begin processing compliance testing and work with you and your MLS vendor as needed
- Once complete, RESO will issue you a Certification Certificate
