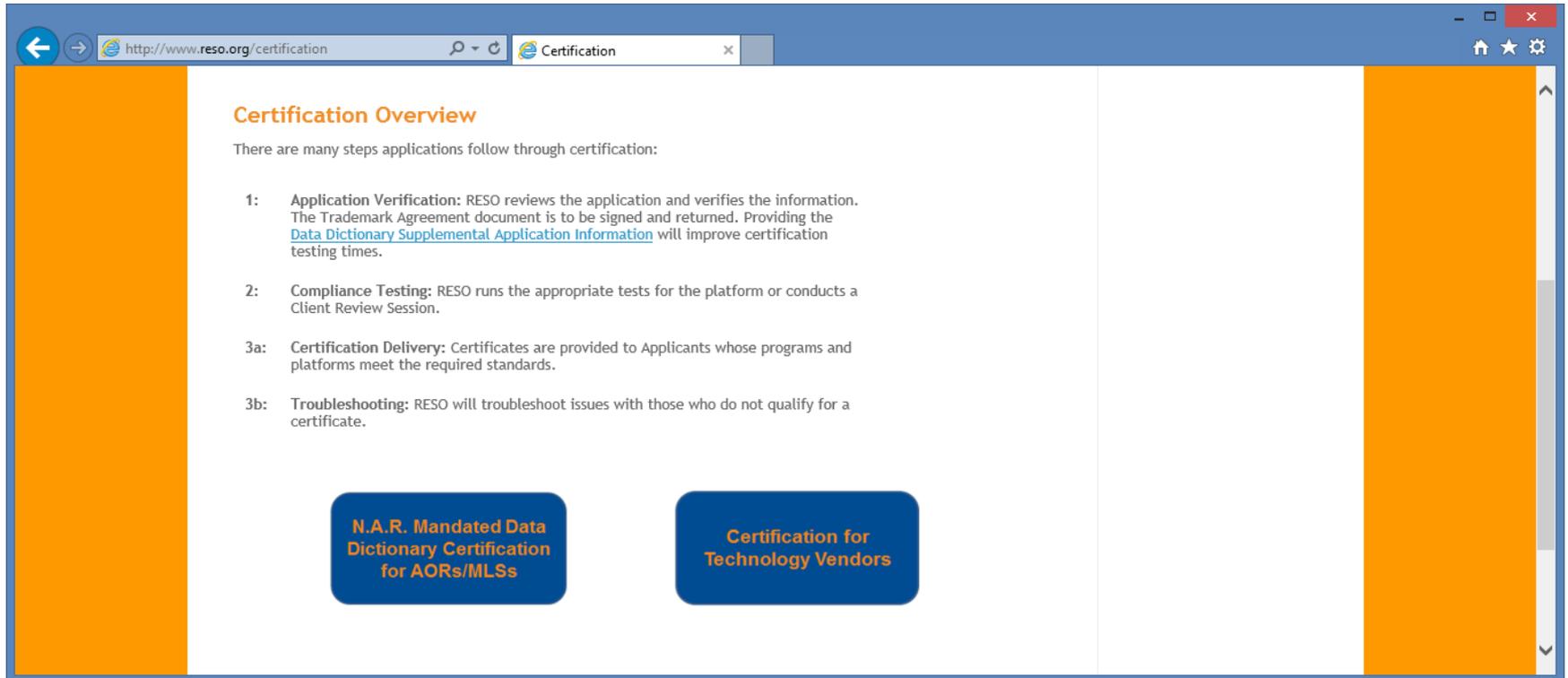
NAR MLS Policy Mandates

- Data Dictionary v1.3 or v1.4 Certification:
January 1st, 2016
- Web API Transport Certification:
June 1st, 2016
- All REALTOR® owned or affiliated Multiple Listing Services must certify through the RESO Certification Program
- The MLS must apply for certification, not the vendor (Data Dictionary

- 1: **Application Verification:** RESO reviews the application and verifies the information. The Trademark Agreement document is to be signed and returned. Providing the [Data Dictionary Supplemental Application Information](#) will improve certification testing times.
- 2: **Compliance Testing:** RESO runs the appropriate tests for the platform or conducts a Client Review Session.
- 3a: **Certification Delivery:** Certificates are provided to Applicants whose programs and platforms meet the required standards.
- 3b: **Troubleshooting:** RESO will troubleshoot issues with those who do not qualify for a certificate.

Vendors: What do I need to do?

- Use Transport Testing Tools to test your systems.
- Visit <https://reso.org/certification> and Apply
- Electronically Sign the RESO Trademark Agreement
- RESO will begin processing compliance testing and work with you as needed
- Once complete, RESO will issue you a Certification Certificate

DD: What do I need to do?

- Contact your MLS Vendor regarding certification
- Work with your MLS Vendor to adopt the Data Dictionary v1.3 or v1.4. This might require “mapping” data
- Visit <https://reso.org/certification> and Apply
- Electronically Sign the RESO Trademark Agreement
- RESO will begin processing compliance testing and work with you and your MLS vendor as needed
- Once complete, RESO will issue you a Certification Certificate
