- Published, approved by the board
- 1.0.2 standard may be downloaded <u>here</u>
- Based on <u>OData 4.0</u> OASIS Standard
- Focused on read access / search
- N.A.R MLS Policy Statement 7.90
- June 30, 2016 is the key date
- Finalizing <u>Entity Data Model</u> for data dictionary
- Current security model is <u>OAuth 2.0</u>
