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Why Standards Matter

- More than 100,000 standards at work in U.S.
- U.S. Department of Commerce estimates standards impact over 80% of global commodity trade
- U.S. Department of Defense projecting a \$789,000,000 cost avoidance over just one program through standards
- Standards helped prevent over 40,000 home fires, 1,400 injuries and 350 deaths annually via standardization of Arc Fault Circuit Interrupters
- Standards allow you to increase innovation, competitiveness and quality while reducing costs and duplicate efforts



What is RESO?

- Independent Non-Profit membership based organization
- Over 700 member organizations (brokerages, tech companies, MLSs/AORs, NAR and standards organizations) comprising of 1000s of subject matter expert volunteers contribute to creating/evolving standards
- Each has equal stake in contributing to the creation and evolution of industry wide standards
- RESO Standards are Free & Open Source to Everyone but ONLY Members can contribute;
- RESO provides certification services to ensure the correct adoption of standards

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




Nearly 100% adoption of RESO Data Dictionary and 50% API Now



What RESO is NOT?

- Does NOT set or enforce IDX/VOW feeds, approvals, policies
- Does NOT set or enforce listing syndication policies, rules or policies
- Does NOT house nationwide MLS data data;
- Does not distribute MLS data directly distribution
- NOT owned or controlled by NAR

Hard to share data on your website from multiple MLS with inconsistent fields



- Duplicate listings
- Inaccuracies
- Limited photos
- No consistent compliance with required IDX rules
- Slower enhancements

 Requires all data consumers (brokers, tech companies) to be RESO Compliant



- Launching requirement for all data consumers (brokers, tech companies) to be RESO Compliant



 Broker and Agent Platform that can launch 40% faster with less resources when utilizing RESO Compliant MLS data feeds



 Can now integrate MLS data within 24 hours and 1 engineer with RESO Compliant MLS data feed, previous efforts took 4-6 weeks



Transitioning entire core infrastructure with 500+ data feeds to the RESO Data Dictionary




